

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capability. Hook type fork carriages have been uniform.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks may vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
